# R09-0021 – Transmitter Only (RG7)



# Q) How long do the batteries last in the transmitter?

A) The batteries should last for approx. 1 year based on 4-5 triggers per day.

# Q) What range do the transmitters have from the monitor?

A) The maximum range will be ~25m clear line of sight however it will be 10-15m indoors depending on the environment. Things like double glazing, metal and solid walls all reduce the range.

### Q) Can we replace the batteries in the transmitter?

A) No. The batteries in the transmitter are a particular li-lion battery and are concealed within the Transmitter. Contact your distributor for a replacement transmitter (RG7).

Warranty is void if this unit is tampered with.

#### Q) How do I program the transmitter to the monitor?

A) You should only need to do this if you need a replacement part or if you have decided to pair a second pad. There is a simple step by step instruction guide available from your distributor. Contact them for further assistance.

### Q) Can I move a transmitter from one pad to another, if necessary?

A) Yes, simply unplug from one mat and plug into the other. It will automatically recognise if it goes from a bed mat to a Floormat etc. There is no programming involved.
